Subject: Adopting and Translating as BPI Technical Regulations Philippine National Standards/Bureau of Agriculture and Fisheries Standards (PNS/BAFS) on Pesticide Residues: Maximum Residue Limits in Asparagus, Okra, Pineapple, Mango, Banana and Rice

Pursuant to Republic Act No. 10611 also known as Food Safety Act of 2013 and Joint Department of Agriculture-Department of Health Administrative Order No. 2015-0007, the following PNS/BAFS are hereby adopted and translated as technical regulations of this bureau for the strict implementation of all concerned:

PNS/BAFS 157:2015	Pesticide Residues in Asparagus: Maximum Residue Limits
PNS/BAFS 158:2015	Pesticide Residues in Okra: Maximum Residue Limits
PNS/BAFS 159:2015	Pesticide Residues in Pineapple: Maximum Residue Limits
PNS/BAFS 160:2015	Pesticide Residues in Mango: Maximum Residue Limits
PNS/BAFS 161:2015	Pesticide Residues in Banana: Maximum Residue Limits
PNS/BAFS 162:2015	Pesticide Residues in Rice: Maximum Residue Limits

This Circular shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation and after fifteen (15) days from registration with the office of the National Administrative Register, UP Law Center.
